### What exactly is the BRAVO Award?

The Conseil de la Coopération de la Saskatchewan (CCS) introduces its new award: The BRAVO Award. This award will be given in recognition to an individual, group, or association who, through activities or projects, contributed to community economic development.

### What do we mean by community economic development?

Community economic development encompasses all the activities that enable an individual or a community to implement projects that

encourage business start-ups and creates employment.

This project can be, for example: a hog barn, specialized training for local businesses, activities creating tourist attractions and / or services, implementing a cooperative, projects having generated investment in a particular region, etc.

### Why this Award?

Individuals, groups or associations whose initiatives, work and successes stand out should be recognized in some way by their peers. A public recognition incites motivation and excellence, which can only benefit the recipients cause.



### Who is eligible?

Any individual, group or association who has implemented a community economic development project.

### What is the prize?

- A work of art by a well-known Fransaskois artist;
- As well, every applicant will receive free leadership training offered by the CCS to encourage them to continue in a leadership role in their respective communities.
